You can make your own, or use our template, colour them in and cut them out or use them as silhouettes. The choice is yours.

Advent 1: A **Star** place a large star at the top of the window

The wise men looked to the stars and where led by the star On a journey to find the new King. We too are called to seek the Lord, the light of the world and to worship him.

Advent2: Angels place an Angel at either side of the star.

The Angels watch over us and bring messages of peace and good will. Not only do the Angels appear to the shepherds we remember that an Angel appears to Zechariah father of John the Baptist, that an Angel appeared to Mary and in a dream Joseph heard from the Angel of the Lord.

Advent 3: Shepherds Place Shepherds & Sheep under one of the Angels.

The Shepherds remind us that Jesus comes as the Good Shepherd seeking out you and me. Shepherds were lowly people, often rough around the ages, hardworking people. But God reveals to them and to us who ever we are that there is good news to be shared.

Advent 4: Kings or Wisemen (or women if you would like) can be

Jesus the King of Kings was to be a King for all the world and all rulers and authorities were to bow before Jesus. We to should humble our selves and worship Jesus.
